






THE PROJECT Objectives and scope

- ✓ <u>ENPI South</u> Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia, Egypt, Jordan, Israel, Occupied Palestinian Territory, Lebanon and Syria.
- ✓ To be <u>associated</u>; Turkey, Croatia, Bosnia-H, Albania and Montenegro.











THE PROJECT Objectives and scope

- The overall objective of the project is to give a <u>follow-up</u> to the first Mediterranean Motorways of the Seas Project.
 - ✓ but with the possibility to include <u>new pilot projects</u> along the 3 years of project duration.




